

Mary: All right.


Taro: And the best place for the wardrobe is (③) to the door, on your (④) when you come in.

3 次の英文は、高校生のさとしさんがニュージーランド (New Zealand) に住む 友人のHollyに送ったメールです。これを読んで、あとの問いに答えなさい。

Hello, Holly,

Last week on a sunny day, I visited my grandmother with my parents. We left our house early in the morning. My father drove his car and took us to my grandmother's house. When we arrived at her house, my grandmother said to me, "Today, I'm going to pick vegetables at the farm. Will you help me?" I said, "Yes, of course. What kind of vegetables can we get?" She did not answer my question and said, "Come with me. You will see them at the farm."

On the farm, she showed me how to pick vegetables from the ground. They were carrots. It was difficult to pick them but I enjoyed it. We started working at ten o'clock. While we were working, my grandmother said, "Japan produced more food many years ago, but we are buying a lot of food from other countries now. Did you know that, Satoshi?" After I heard her words, I became more interested in the food around me.

We finished working at twelve and went back to my grandmother's house. My grandmother made lunch and my parents and I ate the carrots we got. We enjoyed the lunch very much. When I came back home, I remembered my grandmother's words. I thought, "How much food do we produce in Japan? How much food do we buy from foreign countries?"

That night I found the answers to my questions on the Internet. In 2017, 38% of the food we ate was produced in Japan. Then I found another thing about the food produced in Japan. In 1965, 95% of the rice, 100% of the vegetables and 90% of the fruit we ate were produced here in Japan. Forty years later, Japan produced 95% of the rice, 79% of the vegetables and 41% of the fruit we ate. In 2017, we produced 97% of the rice, 80% of the vegetables and 41% of the fruit we ate in Japan. Now I understand that my grandmother's words are right. If we cannot buy food from foreign countries, what should we do? We produce about 100% of the rice we eat. I think (①), too.

I think there is another problem about food. In Japan, we sometimes throw away our food without eating it. I think it is "mottainai." Do you know the word? In some parts of the world, many children die every year, because they do not have anything to eat. I feel (②) about that. Food is very (③) for our life. So we should not throw away so much food. I would like to visit my grandmother again and tell her about the things I learned.

Now I am interested in the food of your country. What do you usually eat? What is your favorite food? Why do you like it? Do you think your country should produce more food? I hope you will send me an e-mail and tell me!

Sandy: It's nice to know that people in your *neighborhood are kind and friendly.

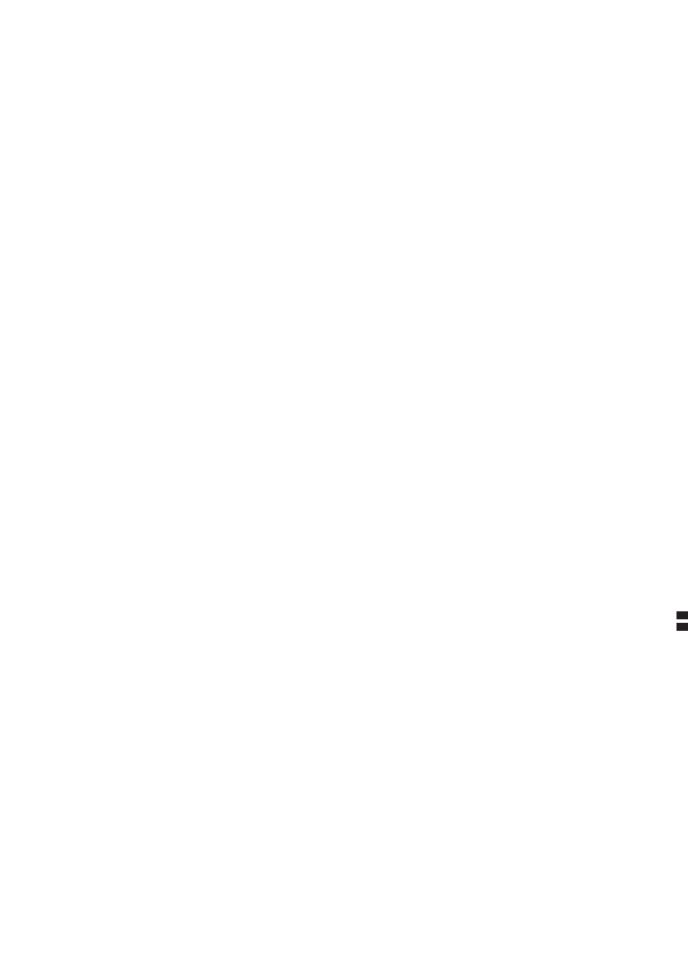
